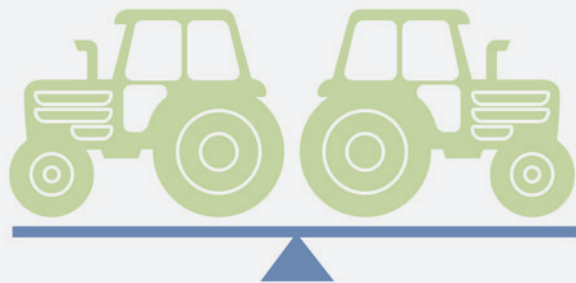
Canada's agriculture sector faces unique labour market challenges in the coming years, and so will the dairy industry.

The dairy industry includes operations that primarily engage in milking dairy cattle. While the dairy industry has shed more than a third of its workers since 2009, it is still a significant agriculture employer, employing 39,900 workers, or 11% of the total agricultural labour force, as of 2014.
