Dr. Annemieke Farenhorst is a professor in the Department of Soil Science, Faculty of Agriculture and Food Sciences, University of Manitoba and the Prairie NSERC Chair for Women in Science and Engineering. Her research program focuses on pesticides, natural steroid estrogens and antibiotics in soil and water, and on community-engagement in water resource management.

Dr. Farenhorst has earned a range of teaching, research and outreach awards, including the Queen Elizabeth II Diamond Jubilee Medal for leadership in pesticide research for strengthening pest control practices in rural communities of Central America, and for mentoring women in science. Dr. Farenhorst is an elected member of the International Union of Pure and Applied Chemistry Committee on Crop Protection Chemistry, and an associate editor for the Journal of Environmental Science and Health, Part B: Pesticides, Food Contaminants, and Agricultural Wastes.
